Retreat Rules

- No electronic devices (I-pods, video games, etc.) are permitted.
- No cell phones. ***Students and parents needing to contact one another may do so through the leaders.***
- No indecent clothing. 1-piece swim suits only.
- Adherence to all retreat center rules.
- Must always move from location to location with a “buddy” (the “buddy-system” includes groups of 2 or more with groups of 2 never including members of the opposite sex).
- Guys and girls may never be alone together or paired off.
- Students may not wander off alone.
- Guys may not enter a girl’s room and vice versus.
- Students may not touch a member of the opposite sex in either forms of rough-housing or affectionate touching.
- Students may not wander off to unapproved locations. Approved locations will be covered at the retreat site.

The following infractions will necessitate immediate parent pick-up from camp:

- Any violent act directed at another person.
- Physical displays of guy-girl affections.
- Significant acts of rebellion.
- Persistent breaking of retreat rules.
- Entering a room of the opposite sex.
- Any other significant disciplinary issue deemed by the leaders as worthy of immediate withdrawal from camp.
